"Out of Darkness" Week 4: The Drama of Idol Destruction

Exodus 7-12

The 10 plagues can be viewed as a drama with some of the elements of drama such as characters, theme, props, and plot helping us to understand what God is doing in the 10 plagues.

1.) The Characters of the drama

- Yahweh is the main character using Moses as His spokesman (Ex 3:14)
- Pharaoh is a second character representing Egypt and its evil system (Ex 5:1-2)
- 2.) The theme of the drama is seen in Exodus 7:5
- And the Egyptians will know that I am the LORD
- when I stretch out my hand against Egypt
- and bring the Israelites out of it.

3.) The Prop used by God and Moses is the staff that turns into a snake and back to a staff again (Ex 4:3-4)

- 4.) The Plot of the plague drama
- Each plague is one by one mocking a god of Egypt to demonstrate God's power
- The ten plagues can be divided into three groups of three plagues, each which help to highlight the theme of making Yahweh known. The tenth plague is set apart as the climactic plague.

5.) Application: What false gods or idols need to be destroyed in our lives and in our society?
