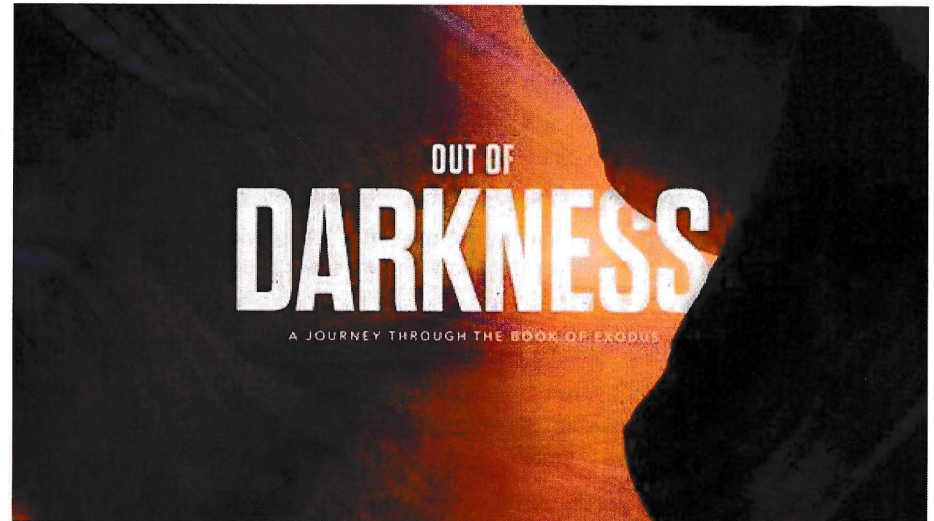

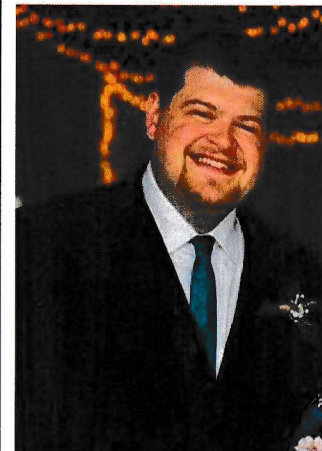

Because of their conversation she evangelized her whole village to believe that Jesus was the Messiah!
